What Happens Once the Programme Has Been Selected?


- Sales will fill in a cost request form for each separate title and send through to production.

- Deliver the books to the children!















By the end of 2018, PRHC will have printed and delivered over 480,000 books throughout the year for the Imagination Library


Imagination Library in Scotland

- All Looked After Children between birth and 5 are eligible
- Funded by the Scottish Government
- All 32 local authorities participate
- Includes children
 - in residential care
 - looked after by <u>kinship carers</u>
 - looked after by <u>foster carers</u>
 - looked after at home
 - adopted
- Approximately 2,344 children receiving books every month



Imagination Library in Scotland

Impact of Bookbug

Evaluation highlighted

- The cumulative impact of getting the books/resources and taking part in activities which model good practice
- Children's responses can be a strong motivating factor
- Once they get going, parents love the time spent looking at books with their children, but still need support especially if they are "time squeezed" or have other barriers to reading.




