

Celebrating five years of Imagination Library in North Lincolnshire



A series of celebration events are taking place across North Lincolnshire to mark the fifth anniversary of hugely popular bookgifting scheme, the Imagination Library.

Since the launch in 2013, we have delivered a whopping 400,000 free books to more than 15,000 children, making a real difference to early literacy.

Extravaganza events have already been held at Brigg, Barton upon Humber, Scunthorpe, Winterton and the Isle, with more celebrations planned for Crowle in June and Epworth in July.


